TOPIC: Fees and Charges

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Talking Points

- As agreed as part of the 2014-15 Budget, the directorate will be increasing fees and charges by 4%. These fees cover development applications, including public notifications, lease administration and survey related costs.
- Fee charged for lease variation remain unchanged.
- Fees related to extension of time to build fees, water abstraction charge, building levy and licence costs have been transferred to the Chief Minister, Treasury and Economic Development Directorate as part of Access Canberra.
- Parking fees will increase by 6%. This revenue is collected by CMTEDD as part of Access Canberra.
