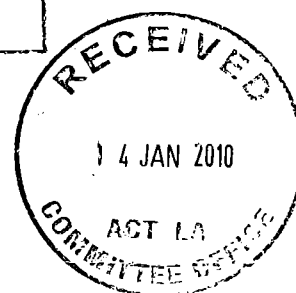

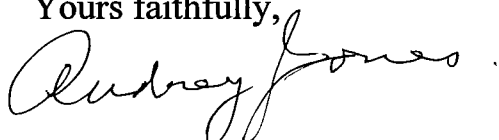
We were able to buy a cottage here in June 1950 and I still live in it and love it.
