Supplementary Question No. 20

The Standing Committee on Education, Training and Young People asked:

- Q20 The risk management process under the Australian New Zealand risk management standard (AS/NZS 4360:2004) (see page 31) requires an assessment to be done on all major projects.
- a. Please provide the risk assessment “identifying, analysing and treating risk exposure” of the Towards 20/20 Renewing Our Schools project that was conducted by the Department, in accordance with those standards.

MR BARR: The answer to the question is as follows:

A comprehensive risk assessment process was undertaken for the *Towards 2020* project, in accordance with the Australian/New Zealand Standard (AS/NZS 4360:2004). The risk assessment formed part of the Government’s consideration of the *Towards 2020* proposal and is therefore classified as “Cabinet-in-Confidence”. As such I am unable to release details of the risk assessment.
