ANDREW WALL MLA: To ask the Minister for Disability, Children and Young People

Ref: Output Class 1: Disability and Therapy Services, CSD Budget Statement page 20

In relation to the new respite property:

1. Who retains ownership of this property?
2. Who will be responsible for ongoing costs associated with the property?
3. Who will provide ongoing maintenance and service provision at the property?
4. Will these services go to tender?

Minister BURCH: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

1. The new respite facility will be retained by the Community Services Directorate and a tenancy agreement will be put in place with the agreed Non-Government organisation responsible for the running of respite services at the property.
2. The Non-Government organisation responsible for delivering respite services from the new property will be responsible for the ongoing operational costs such as electricity and gas. The Community Services Directorate will be responsible for any property ownership costs such as water and sewerage.
3. The Community Services Directorate will be responsible for the ongoing maintenance and service provision at the property.
