Asked by Giulia Jones MLA on 25 June 2014: Minister for Territory and Municipal Services took on notice the following question:

In relation to:

An update on what is happening with negotiations around equestrian land/facilities at the Majura Parkway and at Curtin that are under potential threat.

Shane Rattenbury MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

Approximately 1.4 Hectares of unleased land has been withdrawn from the area used for horse agistment at Duntroon for development of the Majura parkway. Advice from *Territory Agistment*, the Government's contracted horse holding paddock contractor, is that such a small loss of capacity will not require the displacement of any of the current horses agisted at Duntroon.

The only land development occurring in the vicinity of the unleased land used for horse agistment at Curtin is the redevelopment of the old Canberra Brickworks. Based on advice from the Land Development Authority (LDA), these works are not expected to impact the existing horse holding paddocks at Curtin.
