Mr Jeremy Hanson asked the **Minister for Police and Emergency Services**, upon notice, on 26 June 2014:

In relation to: Breath Testing

Mr Hanson: How many breath tests did you conduct in the last financial year? Do you do it by financial year or calendar year?

Mr Corbell: That is reported on a financial year basis and would be included in ACT Policing's annual report. In terms of—

Mr Hanson: I am just wondering, I suppose, with the budget you have got, what you did last year and then what you are anticipating this year for both alcohol and drug testing.

Mr Simon Corbell MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

- (1) For the 2012-13 reporting period, ACT Policing conducted 100,791 Random Breath Tests (RBTs) during this period.
- (2) As at 25 June 2014, ACT Policing had conducted 144,308 RBTs for the 2013-14 period.
- (3) For the 2012-13 reporting period, ACT Policing conducted 2,079 Random Roadside Drug Tests (RRDTs) during this period.
- (4) As at 25 June 2014, ACT Policing conducted 2,545 RRDTs for the period 2013-14 period.
