Loose Fill Asbestos Eradication Scheme

In relation to: Sales

1. What percentage of blocks have been sold at a value lower than the first right of refusal price over the past financial year?
2. What percentage of blocks have been sold at a value higher than the first right of refusal price over the past financial year?

RACHEL STEPHEN-SMITH MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. Zero per cent. The policy does not allow for the sale of properties for a lower value than the first right of refusal offer.
2. There have been 64 per cent of properties sold for higher than the first right of refusal price.
