Asked by Mr James Milligan MLA:

In relation to:

**MR MILLIGAN:** And are you able to give a date on when the works on Hibberson Street will be completed, and all fencing and construction being removed out of that Hibberson Street area in the town centre?

**Ms Fitzharris:** The light rail is all done?

**MR MILLIGAN:** Yes.

**Ms Thomas:** Yes, there is just a tiny little bit left near Gungahlin Place, but we can perhaps take that one on notice. It is pretty minimal now, but partly there is some safety issues. I was just going to say, until the Office of the National Rail Safety regulator fully gives accreditation, part of the reason for having those fences there is not so much because construction activity is still occurring, but really to keep the rail safety zone there so that they can maintain their testing profile before they need to move everything.

**Ms Meegan Fitzharris MLA:** The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

Canberra Metro are currently scheduled to have the Hibberson Street works completed by the end of the year, though construction dates are subject to change. This is will include paving and removing of temporary fences.
