Will the 'Adopt a Park' program have any elements other than the grants? If so, please provide details.

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

Yes. The Adopt-A-Park initiative also provided for increased staffing levels of 1 FTE. As a result, an additional eleven volunteer groups will be supported by the TCCS Urban Parks and Places Volunteer Program. The total number of active volunteer groups is now 46.

The increased staffing will also enable enhanced community stewardship, promote innovative and dynamic ideas, increase volunteer opportunities and recognise efforts of established volunteer groups.
