Asked by James Milligan MLA:

In relation to corporate events held in GIO Stadium over last 12 months:

MR MILLIGAN: That is a great segue into my next question, and that was, how many other events, corporate events, have been held over the last 12 month period at the venue, and a bit of a breakdown on the costs for them to hire the venue and what is involved in opening it up to private sectors to hold events or conferences there?

Mr Elkins: Look I would have to take the exact numbers on notice, but we do work closely to have a wide range of functions and events at GIO Stadium. We work closely to make sure that we are competitive in the market but being such a large space, that considerations will be around making sure we have the appropriate opening and closing, safety and security, for people coming into the venue.

ANDREW BARR MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

There were 39 corporate events held at GIO Stadium in the 2018-19 financial year. A total of \$27,201.46 was paid for venue and equipment hire.
