Asked by Ms Castley on 21 October 2021: Mr Rattenbury took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to:

MS CASTLEY: Last question. Just a quickie. How many public charging stations?

Mr Rattenbury: Across the ACT? I am looking at my colleagues whether anyone knows. We might have to take that on notice.

Minister Rattenbury: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

- There are 37 operational charging stations in the ACT, with varying levels of accessibility to the public.
- Of these 37, only 13 are fully publicly accessible, with the remainder generally located in carparks of hotels, behind entry gates, or having otherwise limited accessibility.
- This information is accurate as at 26/10/2021, however is subject to change.
