Inquiry into ACT Budget 2021–22 ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

In relation to: Stage 2 Southern Memorial Park

A National Cremation Capacity Survey 2020 shows that the ACT private crematorium is operating at 18% capacity.

1. What does ACT Government research show for demand for crematoriums in the ACT?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

1. Current demand identifies that the ACT's current cremation rate is 75 per cent, against a population of approximately 420,000. In comparison, as of 30 June 2016, the New South Wales cremation rate was 66%. To service this, NSW had 49 crematoriums which is equivalent to one crematorium per 155,000 of population.
