In relation to: ACT Executive

THE CHAIR: You might need to take this one on notice, but from 2001 until now how much has been spent by CMTEDD on ministerial office upgrades?

ANDREW BARR MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

In 2018, kitchen and bathroom renovations were completed at a cost of \$13,689.75. In October 2021, a ministerial suite renovation commenced, with an expected cost of \$141,123.52. After the current renovation is completed the ACT Executive will have spent \$154,813.27 on ministerial office upgrades in recent years.

To go back to 2001 would be resource intensive and an unreasonable diversion of government resources.
