Asked by Elizabeth Kikkert: To ask the Assistant Minister for Seniors, Veterans, Families and Community Services

Ref: Community Services, Budget Statement G, p. 4, output class CSD 1.1 Inclusion and Participation, CSD 1.3 Strategic Policy, CSD 1.4 Quality, Complaints and Regulation

In relation to: Community Services Sector Sustainability Review

- 1. When is it expected that the ACT Community Services Sector Sustainability Review will be completed?
- 2. Who is participating in this review?

EMMA DAVIDSON MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- 1. The ACT Community Services Sector Sustainability Review is expected to be delivered to the Industry Strategy Steering Group (a governance body comprised of Government and non-government sector representatives) by the end of this calendar year 2021.
- 2. The Community Services Directorate (CSD) contracted the ACT Council of Social Service (ACTCOSS) to deliver the project, and ACTCOSS entered into an agreement with the University of NSW Social Policy Research Centre (SPRC) to undertake the research. The SPRC is working closely with ACTCOSS and CSD to deliver the review. To develop a sound evidence base for the review, the SPRC has consulted with a broad range of non-government sector organisations in the ACT.
