In relation to: ACT Planning System Review and Reform Project

MR PARTON:

But in regards to the ACT Planning System Review and Reform Project, I just had some questions regarding the community consultation for that project. On page 33, in the case study, you have said that you visited each of the eight urban districts. Can I ask, how many members of the public attended those visits?

Mr Gentleman: Yes, I will pass onto directorate officials for that detail.

Mr Ponton: Thank you, minister.

In terms of the specifics, I may need to take the actual numbers on notice, if that is okay? But what I can say is that that was one component of the engagements. And it was the combination of several years' prior—engagement activities.

We undertook those activities both online and in person. So fortunately it was a point in time when we actually were able to have people participate in person. Some sessions were better attended than others. But—and I might look to my colleague, Ms O'Neill, but I believe they were all in the end fully subscribed, in terms of our COVID safety requirements for those in-person. And then all of them had online participation as well
