Asked by Mrs Nicole Lawder MLA: To ask the Minister for Transport and City Services

Ref: Transport and City Services, Annual Report

In relation to: Domestic Animal Services

- 1. For the 2021 calendar year, can you advise how many new dogs were registered in the ACT?
- 2. For the 2021 calendar year, can you advise how many dog attacks were reported to Domestic Animal Services?
- 3. For the 2021 calendar year, can you advise how many barking dog complaints were reported to Domestic Animal Services?
- 4. For the 2021 calendar year, can you advise how many dogs were seized by Domestic Animal Services?
- 5. For the 2021 calendar year, can you advise how many dogs were euthanised by Domestic Animal Services?

## Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- 1. There were 11,055 new dog registrations in the ACT in the 2021 calendar year.
- 2. There were 624 reported dog attack cases in the ACT in the 2021 calendar year.
- 3. There were 174 dog barking animal nuisance complaints reported in the ACT in the 2021 calendar year.
- 4. 593 dogs were seized by Domestic Animal Services in the 2021 calendar year.
- 5. 22 dogs were euthanised by Domestic Animal Services in the 2021 calendar year.
