In relation to: the ACT Government's response to the Australian Human Rights Commission's Respect@Work Report

1. The ACT Government plans to set out the ACT's long-term commitment to creating a new culture of respectful behaviour in ACT Workplaces by responding to the Australian Human Rights Commission's Respect@Work Report. When is the response expected to be completed and released?

MS BERRY: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. The ACT Government has finalised its formal response to the Australian Human Rights Commission's *Respect@Work* report, setting out its long-term commitment to addressing workplace sexual harassment and embedding a culture of respect across ACT workplaces. This response was tabled in the ACT Legislative Assembly on 3 August 2021 and is available on the ACT Legislative Assembly's website. The Chief Minister also submitted the ACT Government's response to National Cabinet on 30 June 2021.
