KATIE MCKENZIE: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: -

No nursing staff at Dhulwa are credentialed through the Australian College of Mental Health Nurses.

The credentialing process at Canberra Health Services only applies to Nurse Practitioner.

Credentialing by speciality colleges is a voluntary activity undertaken by nurses for their own professional development.
