1. **Can the Minister please provide details on the ACT Government's plans to design and implement a '10 year strategy for the prevention of sexual violence that seeks to change attitudes and behaviours that perpetuate sexual violence,' including the following information:**
 - a. **When will the strategy be expected to be released to public?**
 - b. **How much funding in this Budget has been allocated to the design of this strategy, as well as its implementation?**

Minister Berry: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

1. The ACT Government is committed to implementing a long-term strategy for the prevention of sexual violence to ensure lasting change. Work to develop the strategy will commence in 2022-23.
 - a. The timing for the finalisation of the strategy is yet to be determined. The ACT Government will firstly consult with prevention experts and other stakeholders to ensure the Strategy is enduring and delivers on the expectations of the community.
 - b. The 2022-23 Budget allocated \$933,000 over four years to design and implement the Strategy.
