MR MILLIGAN: Okay, so my question is do you have figures on the number of complaints reported to emergency services, ambulance, fire services and SES, in terms of bullying? Is that recorded anywhere?

Mr Glenn: I think we would need to take that on notice? Yes. Take that on notice, Mr Milligan.

Mick Gentleman MLA: I am advised that the answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

During the period 1 July 2021 to 30 June 2022 there were nil reports of bullying within ESA Operational functions.

One misconduct process involving allegations of bullying by a staff member of ACT Ambulance Service was concluded in 2021/2022 with no allegations substantiated.
