In relation to the 158 tenants relocated

(1) How many formal complaints were made around the relocation process?

(2) How many of those relocated have now applied for a transfer if any?

(a) If yes, why did they request a transfer?

(3) On average how many properties were offered to each tenant before they accepted a property?

Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

(1) Out of the 158 relocated tenants during 2021-22, Housing ACT received 1 formal complaint.

(2) 2 relocated tenants have applied for a transfer.

(a) Both tenants have applied for a transfer as they are seeking additional bedrooms.

(3) In relation to the 158 tenants relocated in 2021-22, on average, 2 property offers were made per tenant.
