In relation to: Boosting what equipment for the ESA

In Budget Statement D, Table 28 identifies \$72,000 in 2023-24 for the works in progress of boosting equipment for the ACT Emergency Services Agency. What equipment, and for which emergency service, is expected to be acquired this financial year?

MICK GENTLEMAN MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

In the 2019-20 ACT Budget, the Government invested through the boosting equipment for the ACT Emergency Service Agency to purchase a new aerial firefighting appliance and a new pumper for ACT Fire & Rescue (ACTF&R). Both the aerial appliance and pumper are currently in operation within ACTF&R.

The \$72,000 identified in Table 28 of 23-24 Budget Statement D is the rollover of the remaining balance of this initiative. These funds will be used in 2023-24 for the procurement of support equipment.
