ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE DURING PUBLIC HEARINGS

Asked by Mr Cain on 31 July 2023: Mr Konti took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to: HRIMS Contractors

MR CAIN: Thank you. I note as well that you advised at QON 1157 it took 23 hours and 45 minutes at a cost of \$2,289 to the ACT taxpayer. Minister, why would you take nearly a day to come up with a list of contractors on this one project?

MR STEEL: I will hand that one to CMTEDD to answer. They were collating the information.

Ms Konti: I will have to take that on notice, Mr Cain, and is it okay if I actually correct what I said last time? I think the question for the QON talked about suppliers involved in the delivery of the HRIMS program, and so I think we provided you the list of the suppliers involved in the delivery; rather than necessarily those that might have been involved in the review, which is Yarrabee Consulting. But nevertheless, I will take on notice the supply of all contractors that may have been involved in the HRIMS program.

Special Minister of State: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

The HRIMS Program was being delivered across 10 Directorates and had approximately 14 system integration points. Many of the contracts for suppliers relating to the systems being integrated originated and were managed by multiple directorates. This resulted in a longer than usual time to gain access to the information required to respond to the question.
