How many times did the Director-General of the Justice and Community Safety Directorate make a final 'delegate' procurement decision, in the financial years 2018-19 to 2022-23?

SHANE RATTENBURY: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

JACS does not maintain a list of who the delegate was for each procurement activity.

To determine how many times the Director-General was the final 'delegate' in a procurement decision would require review of every procurement file in the electronic document record management system over the requested time period.

The request as asked would be an unreasonable diversion of directorate resources.
