ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE

Asked by Leanne Castley MLA on 15 November 2023: Chris Steel MLA took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to:

THE CHAIR: Can you please provide the total money spent on procurement in the ACT for the 2022-23 financial year?

Mr Steel: I certainly can. The last figure I saw was \$2.5 billion, but we can clarify that figure.

Ms Mirzabegian: We will clarify that. I will take that on notice and give you the exact figure.

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

The total money spent on procurement in the 2022/23 Financial year was \$1.41 Billion. This amount is based on the data extracted from financial systems. Please note that the money spent does not correspond to the total estimated value of the notifiable contracts on the notifiable contracts register, as the former reflects actual expenditure, and the latter reflects expenditure that may or may not have occurred as yet.
