THE CHAIR: There was a contract with Colliers International that was executed on 15 March 2021. It expired on 30 June 2021 for commercial advice, which has no specified key performance indicators, no specified delivery and acceptance, no meetings and reports. How can the SLA demonstrate that the contract provided value for money when there were no specified outcomes?
