1. How many dwellings have been purchased from the market as part of the Growing and Renewing Public Housing Program and of those dwellings how many have been
- (i) Class C Adaptable (Australian Standard AS4299);
 - (ii) Silver Livable Housing Design Silver Guidelines;
 - (iii) Gold Livable Housing Design Guidelines.

Yvette Berry: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. As of June 2024, 176 properties have been purchased from the market as part of the Growing and Renewing Public Housing Program. The breakdown is as follows:
 - (i) 30 Class C Adaptable dwellings
 - (ii) 0 Livable Silver dwellings
 - (iii) 0 Livable Gold dwellings

The remaining 146 dwellings purchased were standard design and have, or are, meeting the Housing ACT waitlist demand.
