- (1) Which ACCOs now have the National Regulatory System registration and have any of them been funded as housing providers?

Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- (1) The following ACCOs are National Regulatory System for Community Housing (NRSCH) registered:

- Yerrabi Yurwang Child and Family Aboriginal Corporation
- Yeddung Mura (Good Pathways Aboriginal Corporation)
- SEARMS

Yerrabi Yurwang Child and Family Aboriginal Corporation was successful in the grant opportunity to deliver tenancy and property management services for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who were experiencing, or at risk of experiencing homelessness.

Whilst not funded as a housing provider, Yeddung Mura has been provided two properties for use for supported accommodation.
