Mr Braddock, Andrew: To ask the Minister for Transport —

When will Myway+ app show whether a bus is fitted with bike racks?

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

Transport Canberra has requested this feature of NEC Australia's product development team and the Directorate will continue to advocate for its inclusion in future releases.

Currently, the majority of the Transport Canberra bus fleet is fitted with bike racks and all, new battery electric buses will continue to be fitted with bike racks as part of the commissioning process.

Unfortunately, a small proportion of vehicles within the fleet (3-axle buses) are unable to be safely fitted with bike racks due to their length. These larger buses are often scheduled on frequent Rapid routes to meet higher passenger demand on these services. Transport Canberra will continue to spread out the use of these vehicles on these routes, as much as possible, to avoid consecutive buses without bike racks.
