UPT p.9

THE CHAIR: This might be for the officials, Chief Minister, I am not sure, but does the public service, for example, track—I think they track Liberal commitments in the same way and they track Greens commitments. Has that been a practice in recent elections?

Mr Campbell: That is correct.

THE CHAIR: Were those briefings on Greens commitments shared with the Labor Party or the Chief Minister during that period of negotiations?

Mr Campbell: Sorry, the tracking, or did you say the briefing of them?

THE CHAIR: Yes, well, I guess I am trying to work out exactly what the nature of that analysis is.

Mr Campbell: In terms of the tracking, I will triple check this on notice for you, but it is largely, this is the nature of the commitment made, where it was made, timeframes. It is more a compilation rather than an assessment. But I will take on notice if there is anything further around briefings in the broader sense that you mentioned.
