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6) Does the right have any considerations for how the ACT Government should approach the next climate change strategy? If so what are these?

All rights in the Act need to be considered when developing government policy and legislative amendments. A right to a healthy environment would give rise to certain general obligations that would require immediate action by the Government. In addition, there would be an obligation on the Government to take further positive measures to improve the enjoyment of the right via appropriate means and **within available resources**.

In drafting the next climate change strategy, the development of any proposed new action or objectives will consider if any of the rights outlined in the Act may be impacted, including the right to a clean, healthy and sustainable environment.

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
