MISS NUTTALL: That is very kind. How many ACT Housing properties did we sort of in essence lose over the last year?

MS BERRY: Sorry, what was that? How many—

MISS NUTTALL: How many properties did we lose over the last year from our existing stock?

MS BERRY: Our stock is growing. So we are not going backwards.

MISS NUTTALL: I suppose probably in terms of like demolitions, in terms of existing housing that was essentially taken off stock.

MS BERRY: Yes. I think we have got that information somewhere.

Ms Shields: We will do.

MS BERRY: I might have to take it on notice for you.

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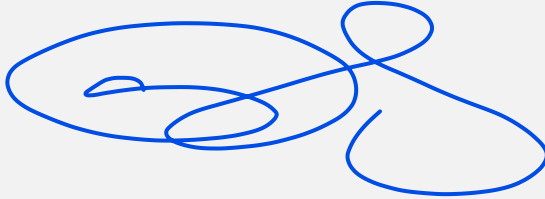
Ms Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

In the 2024–25 financial year, 46 properties were sold as they had reached the end of their useful life and were no longer suitable for the public housing portfolio.

In addition, 40 properties were demolished as part of the Growing and Renewing Public Housing Program. These demolition sites are being redeveloped and will deliver 86 new dwellings, supporting the growth and renewal of public housing stock.
