1. What was agreed between the Government and Hindmarsh Group relating to the repositioning of the C4 cycleway north of Wilbow Street, Phillip, and the addition of a crossing on Wilbow Street for the C4 cycleway?
2. Will Hindmarsh Group be required to bear the cost of relaying the surface of the repositioned section of the C4 cycleway to an acceptable standard? If not, why not?
3. CED have advised that the construction of a raised priority crossing for the C4 cycleway at Wilbow Street cannot commence until after bus diversions related to the construction of the new Woden Bus Interchange. Is this project funded in the 2025-26 budget?

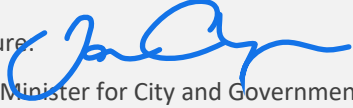
Ms Tara Cheyne MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

1. The Government and Hindmarsh Group agreed that Hindmarsh will complete all works related to the relocation of the C4 cycleway and install an at grade pedestrian crossing on Wilbow Street (including required lighting upgrades). The Government has retained \$20k from the bond of this development to assist with the construction of the raised pedestrian crossing at later stage.
2. The developer is currently finishing their off-site works including the C4 cycleway. All works will be completed by Hindmarsh as per the territory's standards. Officers from the City and Environment Directorate will undertake a post construction inspection in the coming weeks and assets will be formally handed over to the territory. Any defects / outstanding items will be rectified by Hindmarsh.
3. No. Any balance of future funding (excluding the \$20k held from Hindmarsh) will need to be considered via future budget processes.
