Having interim targets that we have missed, have you reported those to cabinet and to the working group? Has that been reported up the line?

tell us where you have reported that you are—which targets you have missed and where you have, like, what governance body you have reported that to?

Minister Berry: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

The Suburban Land Agency's performance against 2025-26 annual land release targets for both residential dwellings and non-residential land (including commercial land) are reported to government on a quarterly basis.

Targets are set for the full financial year with results being reported via the Statement of Performance included within the Annual Report.
