**Subject:** Inquiry into the provision of municipal services in Canberra

Good afternoon

As part of the inquiry into the provision of municipal services in Canberra I would like to submit my concerns I have about local government services in the Woden area of the ACT.

My concerns are:

- the upkeep of the medium strip on Callam St Phillip between the intersections of Hindmarsh Drive and Matilda Streets
- graffiti in the Phillip and Woden areas. I have attached some photos, and I have reported this several times since January this year via fix my street, and writing to various ministers including Chris Steele, Tara Cheyne .

Please note the graffiti is not on privately owned assets and is mainly on Ainsworth St and Chaseling St on fencing, utility boxes, street signs, street lights and the like.

- The deterioration of large green street signs on Hindmarsh Drive, near the intersection of Yamba drive heading east to the airport, Yamba Drive heading south from Canberra Hospital and Yarra Glen in Curtin heading south.

Despite providing feedback, lodging requests via fix my street, writing to ministers etc etc little action has taken place.

I have received confirmation of my correspondence some time later and I have attached one of these emails from Tara Cheyne and Marisa Payne.

The continued neglect and damage in our neighbourhood raises concerns about where public money is going and the deterioration of the appearance of our city and suburbs.

I have also attached some photos, and I am happy to be contacted for more details.
