Interim report tabled – Inquiry into the operation of the 2024 ACT Election and the Electoral Act 1992

Today the Chair of the Standing Committee on Integrity Commission and Statutory Office Holders, Mr Ed Cocks MLA, tabled an interim report for the Committee's *Inquiry into the operation of the 2024 ACT Election and Electoral Act 1992*.

The report made five recommendations intended to address issues that could be resolved most quickly. The purpose of this approach is to minimise delays in progressing legislative reforms required before the next election.

The Committee thanks the ACT Electoral Commission, the Attorney-General and all submitters and witnesses for their engagement in this inquiry.

Under the Assembly's standing orders, the Government is required to respond to committee reports within four months of tabling.
