Incident Management

Steps that were taken or will be taken to prevent or minimise this type of incident in the future

Detailed description of the incident including nature of risk, time, cause, etc.

As the kindergarten children were sitting down waiting for afternoon tea, P01 was at the other end of the room reading out the allergy chart to P01. Before she had finished reading it the afternoon which contained sesame seeds had been served to P01. P01 is anaphylactic to sesame seeds, P01 ran over to P01 but he has already taken a small bite. P01 and P01 were both helped him to wash his face and give him water. P01 came directly to P01, P01 the 2IC and explain what had happened. P01 went directly to the room to assess the situation and ask the educators what had happened. P01 did not appear to be having any reaction. P01 took the medication from the buddy bag and went to call P01's mother. P01 rang and explained the situation, P01 mentioned that he had not presented with any symptoms as yet and that we would be monitoring him closely. P01 went on to confirm that all his medication was up to date. P01 advised that we would contact the mother if they noticed any difference in his behaviour or physical appearance. The educator stayed with him until his mother collected P01 at 4.25pm. No medication was needed.

Actions Taken

It appears that when the allergy chart was updated P01's allergy was left off the chart in the kitchen. This has now been rectified.

A full review of the allergy chart will be completed to ensure that all allergies are accounted for and registered on the chart.
