### Report released for the Inquiry into E-Petition 007-25: Build a new gym for Lyneham High School

Today the Standing Committee on Social Policy released its report for the *Inquiry into E-Petition 007-25: Build a new gym for Lyneham High School*. The report made four findings and three recommendations in relation to the gym itself and the associated community consultation process.

Committee Chair, Mr Thomas Emerson MLA, said, 'We encourage further consideration of the Lyneham High School gym upgrades to ensure public funds are best used to meet the needs identified by the community and avoid further expenditure in the near future.'

'The Committee thanks all who made submissions to the inquiry, particularly those who took the time to share their personal experiences with the school and community sports.'

Under the Assembly's standing orders, the government is required to respond to committee reports within four months of tabling.
