MRS JONES: Just quickly then, you said you are expecting 1,000 contractors to be affected. And how many other businesses or how many employees of other businesses?

Mr Barr: We will take that part of it on notice, but those 1,000 obviously are employees of various—

Treasurer: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

It is expected that the amendment to the Payroll Tax Act to abolish the 'genuine employer' exemption, will impact around 1,000 contractors. The businesses impacted will be those which are associated with these 1,000 contractors.
