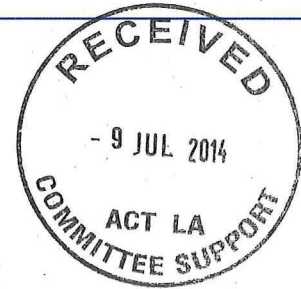

**ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE  
DURING PUBLIC HEARINGS**

Asked by Mr Doszpot on 27 June 2014: Ms Priest took on notice the following question(s):

[Ref: Hansard Transcript 27 June 2014 [PAGE 1226] Woden athletics facility.

**Mr Doszpot:** What financial assistance has been offered to the Woden club, it having been relocated from their current home ground of Woden all the way to Kaleen?

**Ms Priest:** I would have to take that one on notice, Mr Doszpot.

MINISTER BARR: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

The Woden Valley Football Club has been offered no financial assistance to temporarily relocate from Woden Park, noting that Capital Football provided the club with a number of alternate venues to consider for their home games this season (Hawker enclosed oval and Kaleen enclosed oval).

The temporary venue chosen (Kaleen Enclosed Oval) has a recently upgraded canteen, which provides the club with the opportunity to run a canteen and generate revenue. The linemarking requirements for the club at Kaleen are no different to what would have been in place if they were at Woden Park.
