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To whom it may concern,

I recently surrendered my house after the Mr Fluffy buyback program was introduced by the ACT Government. This email relates to the application made by the government for the relaxation of the zoning laws specific to RZ1 blocks affected by Mr fluffy. My block is 940 square metres and falls within the criteria for the asbestos task force to subdivide and then sell as two separately titled blocks. I had intended on buying this block back and building a new house on the block. However with the proposed changes and the likelihood of the block being split, the price of the two blocks will be inflated and in turn too expensive for me to buy back.

I see it as an abuse of process and of the entire Mr Fluffy situation that the asbestos task force is potentially able to circumvent the zoning laws which would normally apply to any one else wishing to split the title of an RZ1 block. As such I completely oppose the application made by the taskforce, not only because it will affect me in my desires to rebuild on a block which I was compelled to sell because of a bungled government initiative, but also because the government of all people should have to comply with the laws it put in place in the first place, and should not be allowed to change laws because it suits their agenda.
