- 2) What is the Heritage Advisory service? Who nms it?
- 3) What was the \$52,000 Heritage emergency fund spent on?

MICK GENTLEMAN: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

\$52,000 was allocated to the Heritage Emergency Fund, and of that \$17,155 was released to St John's Schoolhouse Museum Reid for urgent conservation works. Unspent monies are rolled into the following year's allocation.
