Annual Report TCCSD Volume 1, Transport, Strategic Indicator 2.2: Business performance

In relation to: Free travel

1. Will a period of free travel be provided when the new public transport network is implemented in 2019?
2. If so, who will be eligible for free travel?
3. Will MyWay tap -on and tap-off be required to access free travel?
4. What is the projected cost of this period free travel in foregone farebox revenue?

Meegan Fitzharris MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. Yes.
2. All customers who tap on and tap off using a MyWay card on bus and light rail services during the free travel period will be eligible for free travel. Additionally, other customers who are ordinarily eligible for free travel will continue to be eligible for free travel during this period, whether or not they use a MyWay card.
3. Yes.
4. \$2.2 million.
