In relation to: Finalisation of plans of management

MS LE COUTEUR: Okay. Minister, you mentioned the plans of management. So with all the new rural leases, has the government organised plans of management for them all?

Mr Gentleman: I think we are working through that at the moment. I am not sure if all of them are completed.

Mr Ponton: My understanding is that the Suburban Land Agency have submitted them all for consideration but whether they are all finalised, I would have to take that on notice.

MINISTER GENTLEMAN: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

Of the outstanding Land Management Agreements (LMAs) required for rural leases managed by the Suburban Land Agency (SLA), three are complete. The remaining LMAs have been progressed by the SLA and the Rural Programs Unit within Parks and Conservation Service and are expected to be complete by the end of year.
