Question: Can we clarify how much money and can we clarify the timetable?

Minister Stephen-Smith: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

The Government has committed \$50.050 million in capital funding for the expansion of the Centenary Hospital for Women and Children.

This capital project is scheduled to be completed in June 2022, subject to clinical operational constraints.

The figure of \$65.5 million, as quoted in the ACT Government submission, is the capital and recurrent funding relating to the expansion of the Centenary Hospital for Women and Children over three years.
