PETER CAIN: To ask the Minister for Planning and Land Management

Ref: Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate, Budget Statements E, 2021-22

In relation to:

ACT Land and Property Reports

- 1. The Auditor-General's report no. 4, 2020, on land supply and release (p. 13) found significant improvements should be made to ACT Land and Property Reports to improve their utility for the community, including publishing them as soon as possible.
 - a. When will the ACT Land and Property Report for January to June 2021 be published?

- 2. When coming up with the targets for the current ILRP, were actual figures of dwellings in the pipeline used, per recommendation 3 of the Auditor-General's report no. 4, 2020, on land supply and release, noting this recommendation was agreed to in the government response to the report?
- 3. When the ILRP targets are set, is the Suburban Land Agency's capacity to deliver land, and its past performance taken into account?
- 4. Regarding the 356 'infill' single residential blocks (ILRP 2025-26, p. 7) identified for release between now and 2026, where will those be located?
