More broadly, I am also interested in exploring, when someone does in fact cap out their TOIL, how their overtime is recorded.

Mr Barr: I do not know. I do not carry the work hours of every executive in my head. I will have to take that on notice. And we will provide the answer to your second question on notice as well.

ANDREW BARR MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

As of 27 October 2021, there were thirteen staff members that capped out their TOIL at 100 hours.
