In relation to: Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Policy and Engagement

- 1. Table 5 in Budget Statement G shows a funding increase of nearly \$4 million for Strategic Policy.
  - a. How much of this funding increase will go to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Policy and Engagement?
  - b. What will it be used for?

RACHEL STEPHEN-SMITH MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- a. In 2021-22, \$0.998 million of the funding increase will go to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Policy and Engagement.
- b. This funding will be used to support the operation of the independent *Our Booris, Our Way* Implementation Oversight Committee and to continue to grow the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander community-controlled sector focusing on children, young people and families.
