1. Officials from the ACT Government and its advisors engaged with various stakeholders from across the ACT Government, the Canberra Region Joint Organisation, City of Sydney, NSW Environment Protection Authority and Food Organic and Garden Organic technology providers, facility operators and project financiers.
2. The ACT Government is considering the citywide rollout of a Food Organic and Garden Organic service. Information on the proposed service will be released once a decision is made by Government on the citywide rollout.
