ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE DURING PUBLIC HEARINGS

Asked by MR COCKS on 24 August 2022: KATIE MCKENZIE took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to:

How many times has the public advocate been notified late of a consumer in seclusion?

KATIE MCKENZIE: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

Mental Health staff meet regularly with the Public Advocate in relation to seclusion. To date, the Public Advocate has not raised concerns with the reporting.

The Mental Health Act 2015 (the Act) does not contain a timeframe in which the Public Advocate is to be notified of the seclusion, the language used in the Act is simply, "tell the public advocate in writing of the restraint, involuntary seclusion or forcible giving of medication".

It is Mental Health, Justice Health and Alcohol and Drug Services (MHJHADS) procedure to inform the Public Advocate within 12 hours of a seclusion occurring.

MHJHADS also send a monthly list of all seclusions to the Public Advocate as a cross check to ensure they have received notification of all seclusions.
